



HLTAID003 – Provide First Aid

Course Cost: \$140 per person

Mode of Delivery: Online (Theory) & Face-to-face (Practical)

Pre-requisites: Nil

Certification issued: Statement of Attainment – Provide First Aid

Certificate valid: 3 years. This is specified by the Code of Practice – First Aid in the Workplace. An annual update of resuscitation (CPR) skills is recommended by Australian Resuscitation Council and specified by the Code of Practice – First Aid in the Workplace.

Who should attend: This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to a casualty. The unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. All businesses in Australia have to provide a safe workplace for all employees, visitors and contractors.

Online Component: The theory component of this course involves completing online pre-work on our e-learning website. The student will be required to read the provided materials and complete an online quiz. This will take approx. 3 hours.

Practical Component: Once the theory component has been completed the student will be required to attend a face-to-face session at our training facility to complete the practical assessment. This will take approx. 2.5 hours.

Physical requirement: Learners undertaking CPR training must demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor. This requirement must be met in full and it is not appropriate for the manikin to be placed on a table or similar. If you think that you will not be able to demonstrate this competency, please let us know prior to the course.

Location of Training: Our training centre is located in Gladstone, Central Queensland. Alternately courses can be booked onsite at your preferred location.
